**Fall Workshop on Saturday, October 23, 2010**

**Workshop Leader: Rainer Beckmann** is a graduate of the Utrecht School of the Arts, Netherlands. He is a first prize winner at the Holland Open Recorder Festival Competition and the Performance Contest of the Dutch Concert Agency. He has performed in Germany, the Netherlands, France, Belgium, Italy, and Israel. In Brazil, he has taught recorder and music history at the State University of Ceará and collaborated with ensembles that play Early Music as well as Brazilian popular and traditional music. Recent engagements include performances and recordings with La Bernardinia Baroque Ensemble, Tempesta di Mare, Vox Ama Deus, Piffaro, Mélomanie, and the American Society of Ancient Instruments. Rainer teaches at the Pennsylvania Academy of Music where he is the director of the school's Early Music program, and he directs the Greater Philadelphia Recorder Academy.

*\*Directions to Cathedral Village from PA Turnpike: Use Exit #333 Norristown. Take the ramp for Germantown Pike East. Immediately merge into the left lane of traffic on Germantown Pike. Continue on Germantown Pike to the third light (Joshua Road). Turn right. Continue to first light (Ridge Pike). Turn left onto Ridge Pike. Continue to the seventh traffic light (Cathedral Road).
